We've been reporting to our churches in Arizona and New Mexico since mid-February. It has sure been wonderful to get re-acquainted with our supporters and even meet some pastors from churches that have changed pastors since we were on deputation. Some of these churches we have not been in since our initial deputation more than 18 years ago! We thank God for the faithfulness of our supporting churches! One church had around 50 members when we presented our ministry and had over 800 in attendance the Sunday we were with them. Our plans right now include visiting some churches in Northern New Mexico, Colorado, and Wyoming this summer and then in late August through late November to be in Oklahoma, North Texas and Arkansas.
