My how time flies! We are entering our 18th year as missionaries. When we started there were 5 in our family, Leah was 3 months old, Zach was 9 and Amanda just 11. Now it is just the two of us as missionaries. Gratefully all of our family (including our grandsons) live in El Paso so we do get to see them from time to time.

2016 started off with a bang with lots of activities in the month of January. We celebrated our newest church's first anniversary on Feb. 7th, and then promptly started our furlough. This is our first furlough for 12 years (although we have visited a few of our churches). We have not reported to some of our supporters since we were on our initial deputation. I had planned one 3 years ago but due to my broken hip had to cancel as I could not travel at that time.

The Lord had other plans for us as during that span of time we were needed to reinforce one of the churches we had turned over to national leadership for a year and then we started the newest church. The Lord's plan is always best although at times we have difficulty seeing His plan.

Please pray for us this year as we will be traveling for the majority of the year. We plan to be in Arizona for the bulk of the spring, then to Colorado and Wyoming in the summer then Oklahoma, Texas and Arkansas for the fall. We are also using this time to take care of some needed medical attention. We have not been to a medical doctor other than for colds and my hip for nearly 20 years. Kelly had her gall bladder removed on Feb. 19th pray for her quick recuperation. I will be visiting the doctor starting in March.

Iglesia Bautista "Maranatha" – Cd. Juárez, Chihuahua – This church is doing well and has grown steadily in maturity and number. We started this church in April of 2014 although we met outdoors for the first 9 months. In Feb. of 2015 we finally got a place to meet and celebrated the 1st official anniversary on Feb 7th. Since pastor Angel Luna had pastoring experience this work progressed rapidly and is now functioning on its own under his leadership. They are dedicated to reaching their area and even support another new church plant not too far away.

Iglesia Bautista "Castillo Mío" – Cd. Juárez, Chihuahua. Pastor Manuel Garcia and this church spent about 6 months gathering winter jackets for those in need. Just before Christmas they had over 100 jackets to give away at a special Christmas program. They did a great job of singing and presenting the gospel in the open air and then were able to be a blessing to all those that came in need of a coat. Many souls were saved and there has been several new families attending church since this great event!

Iglesia Bautista "Esperanza Mia" – Cd. Juárez, Chihuahua. I was invited to preach at this church in late January and felt truly blessed to be there. Pastor Albert DeAnda and this church are doing a great job reaching the lost in this area. Bro. DeAnda's son is attending a Bible institute nearby. Bro DeAnda has expressed his desire for this church to multiply. They are starting Bible studies in a nearby area with one of their faithful men.

> Although the Lord has allowed us to have part in helping establish 8 churches, we work closest with these 3. All 3 Pastors have expressed their desire to establish more churches in the future. Please pray that the Lord would reveal his will not only to them but to us as well as we desire to serve the Lord until he returns or until he takes us home to heaven.
