Greetings once again from the El Paso / Juarez border. Although COVID restrictions on the U.S. side of the border have relaxed considerably, they remain in place on the Mexican side. The restrictions on the bridge prohibiting non-essential travel remain in place so we are still waiting to be able to resume all our activities in Juarez. Hopefully on June 21st.

2nd Timothy 2:2 (above) has been a theme of our ministry since the beginning. We know that God's Word is always profitable for everything, and we are experiencing the Holy Spirit's wisdom firsthand on our mission field. One of the men I learned from said, "Don't do anything on the mission field that wouldn't continue if you had to leave the field in 90 days." He said he learned from sad experience the reality of countries closing and expelling missionaries. Although the current situation is not the same, the principle is sure true in our case.

Even though we've not been able to be an in-person participants with our churches in Mexico, I am happy to report they are all continuing to be faithful and moving forward during these challenging times. Praise the Lord for faithful men!

Iglesia Bautista de la Gracia, Bermejillo Durango – We're so encouraged by the news from this church that we helped start 15 years ago. Pastor Lorenzo who was saved, trained, and ordained by this church and Pastor Angel Luna continues to lead it in reaching more souls. There is a small group of church members in a nearby town that have had trouble with reliable transportation to church so, one believer donated a piece of property and they have begun construction a small mission in the town and are holding a regular service there.
